Magnificent vintage in Toro with a cold and rainy spring that slowed the growth cycle and caused occasional frosts. Severe green-pruning took place to lighten the production and ensure flawless development of maturation, after a late veraison with a final stretch of summer with cool nights. A long harvest began locally in September and generally from October 5th with excellent acidity and moderate alcoholic levels.

A very expressive nose with a pronounced mineral character, balsamic aromas and notes of graphite. Broad, succulent, great freshness and persistence.

San Roman 2013 was bottled in March 2016 after spending 24 months in barrels of French and American oak both new and used. A light extraction of the grapes was carried out to obtain aromatic delicacy and fine tannins.

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
